It's a piece that owed much to the political cabarets of Brecht and Weill and was being rehearsed by the inmates of Thereseinstadt when, only a few months after the infamous Red Cross committee inspection to this 'model' Jewish resettlement town, a visiting

Gestapo officer noticed that the megalomaniacal Emperor bore an uncanny resemblance to Hitler. The performance was cancelled and composer and performers were sent to Auschwitz. *The Emperor of Atlantis* received its first ever performance in Amsterdam in 1975, and it's getting some more in Perth in June from the Lost and Found Opera company. Andrew Ford talks to artistic director & conductor Chris van Tuinen and Rabbi David Freilich from the Perth Hebrew Congregation Synagogue, where the performances are taking place.
